Accelerated Degree Programs at Drexel

Quality and innovation are synonymous with Drexel's academic programs. What if you already know that your ultimate career goal calls for more than a bachelor's degree?

Accelerated degree programs enable academically qualified students to earn both a bachelor's and an advanced degree — graduating sooner than they would in traditional programs. Depending upon the academic major, eligible students can be admitted to an accelerated degree program in one of two ways:

- Apply for provisional admission into an accelerated degree program as an incoming freshman and meet the requirements set by Undergraduate Admissions
- Apply for an accelerated degree program as a Drexel Student through the Office of Graduate Studies after completing 90 credits, but no more than 120 credits
