

HONORS OPTION GUIDELINES

Students register for a non-Honors course at Drexel can enrich the class by doing additional research, writing, or special projects in the course. In recognition of this work, the student is issued Honors credit for the course in addition to course credit. To pursue this option, the student and the Instructor must develop a course of study worthy of Honors distinction. (Enrichment and Audited courses are not available for Honors Option study.)

PROCEDURE

- ◆ During the first week of the term, the <u>student</u> should develop a plan as to how to enrich the course and consult with the Course Instructor for suggestions/enhancements/changes. We strongly encourage students to consult with their Course Instructor during the first few days of the term to discuss the possibility of an Honors Option in the course. The decision to grant or deny the student's request to pursue an Honors Option for a particular course is within the discretion of the Instructor and is subject to approval by the Honors College.
- ♦ Once the Instructor approves the plan of study, the <u>student</u> should complete the Honors Options Request Form in full detail (typed or written in ink) Incomplete forms will not be accepted. After the student completes the form, the Instructor should review and sign it.
- ♦ By allowing three weeks for students to discuss the Honors Option with their Instructor and obtain approval from both their Instructor and the Honors College, students are expected to describe their course enrichment plan in full detail.
- ♦ The student is responsible for submitting the Request form to the Honors Office prior to the deadline and obtaining approval from the Honors College.
- ♦ <u>NEW PROCESS</u> At the end of the term, the <u>student</u> needs to obtain a signed Honors Option Completion Form from his/her professor and submit it to the Honors Office by the stated deadline. The student is responsible for retrieving the Instructor's signature in order to earn the Honors Option credit.
- Students may register for no more than two (2) Honors Options per term. Students who wish to pursue more than two Honors Options in a single term are required to meet with an Honors Program staff member for special approval.

DEADLINES:

- ◆ Honors Option **Request** Forms MUST be completed in full detail (with the required Instructor's signature), delivered to the Honors College <u>AND</u> approved by the Honors College no later than the third (3rd) Friday of the Term − 5:00pm.
- ♦ NEW PROCESS Honors Option Completion Forms MUST be completed in full and with the required Instructor's signature AND submitted to the Honors Office no later than the final business day of the term in which it was requested − 5:00pm.

GRADES

♦ In order to receive Honors credit for the course the student must earn a grade of "B-" or better in the course in addition to completing the enrichment work detailed in the Honors Option Form to the Instructor's satisfaction. The student's grade should *not* be dependent on the work completed for the Honors Option credit.

CREDIT

♦ At the end of the Term, the <u>student</u> will submit the Honors Option Completion Form to the Honors Office. The Honors College will review the forms and confirm that the student has earned a grade of 'B-'or higher. After these conditions have been met, an "H" (indicating Honors credit) will be issued for the course on the student's permanent transcript. Once issued, the student may view their Honors credit through DrexelOne, viewing their academic transcript, and seeing the words "Course taken for Honors Credit" underneath the name of the course.
