## Quick Links

1. From the Quick Links menu on the left side of any Law Library webpage, click on HeinOnline. If you are accessing from off-campus, you may be prompted to login.

## Electronic Databases list

1. From the Law Library homepage, go to the Electronic Databases page under Resources.
2. Find "HeinOnline" in the Databases list.
3. Click on the title to go to the resource. If you are accessing from off-campus, you may be prompted to login.

## Catalog Search for Individual Journals

1. To find a particular journal on HeinOnline, simply search the Law Library Catalog by Keyword or Title.
2. To search the Catalog, enter your terms into the search box on the upper-left of any Law Library webpage.
3. You may also access the catalog by clicking on the "Search the Catalog" link under Resources.

# HeinOnline

*Electronic Resources*

**HeinOnline** is an extensive collection of law e-journals and e-books, with over 1,200 law and law-related periodicals and over 1,000 books in the Legal Classics collection. It also features several other collections, described in the Subject Areas section of this brochure.



**HeinOnline** is unique in both its presentation and its scope. All content on Hein is page-image (PDF) based, which maintains the original layout of the print document, along with images, charts, pagination, etc. This ensures the authenticity of a document in an electronic environment.

In addition, **HeinOnline** includes full retrospective coverage of all of its e-journals, containing every issue back to the first volume. As most law resources don't offer this level of coverage, **HeinOnline** is often the only electronic source for these materials. Current coverage of journals is sometimes limited by a "blackout period" of several years, so you may need to find recent journal articles in print or through other Law Library resources.

### Searching in HeinOnline:

#### Basic Search:

1. After selecting a Library or Collection from the Welcome Screen, click on the "Search" tab.
2. Select "Word" or "Phrase Search" and enter your search term(s).
3. From your Search Results list, click on the citation link to go to the result, or click on "View Matching Text Pages" to see exactly where your search terms occur within the result.

#### Field Search / Advanced Search:

For more control over your search, click on the Field or Advanced Search links in the Search tab.

**Advanced Search** allows you to restrict your search by title, document type, and date range.

**Field Search** lets you additionally restrict your search by fields such as Author, Description, and Title. It also allows you to create a Boolean search



**HeinOnline** supports SFX linking from other resources, such as periodical indexes. However, SFX linking does not currently take you directly to the article you request. To find your article, you will need to locate your journal from the alphabetical list, and then locate the article within the journal.
