**Second-year students** who plan to pursue a concentration should organize their schedule carefully to ensure they take essential required and pre-requisite courses. The required courses for the Fall 2010 Semester are:

A student must take these classes in the Fall semester of the second year if the student intends to complete the Concentration. For both the Business and Intellectual Property concentrations, failure to complete these courses in the Fall of the second year WILL PRECLUDE completion of the Concentration.

Those classes marked as "required" are core courses for the concentration; the others count as electives.
