First Impressions	 Lack of professional grooming, head to toe; you wear the same casual attire you wear to class Failure to introduce yourself with a firm handshake Lack of enthusiasm 	 You look like the person that has the job vs. the person trying to get the job You have a good introduction, but lack energy and enthusiasm 	 Your attire is polished and suited for the industry You introduce yourself with a confident handshake and good eye contact Your first impression is instantly engaging/you're just oozing with enthusiasm
Non-Verbal Communication	 Poor eye contact Poor posture Distracting body language (ex. playing with your hair) 	You have inconsistent eye contact	You maintain good eye contact, posture and poise throughout the interview
Verbal Communication	 You answer questions with short or yes/no responses You use a lot of filler words, "uh" "um" "like" You do not consistently provide concrete examples of your experience and how it relates to the job 	 You can state your strengths and skills, but do not provide concrete examples You use some filler words, but not enough to be a distraction 	You relate your skills and experience to the position with concrete examples and demonstrate why you are a good fit, using the STAR method
Preparation	 You are unfamiliar with the company and job description Your resume is folded in your back pocket or you've forgotten to bring extra copies of your resume. You have no questions at the end of the interview You forget to ask for a business card and send a follow-up thank you email/note 	 You are familiar with the job description, but not the company You have 1-2 questions written down to demonstrate your interest and preparation You ask for a business card, but forget to follow-up with a thank you within 48 hours 	 You are knowledgeable about the position and the organization. You've done your research and know the key players Your portfolio is prepared with your resume, job description, questions, and examples of your work You have 3-5 prepared questions and ask additional questions that are reflective of the company and the position You follow up with a personalized thank you email within 48 hours.
