Our Accelerated Career Entry (ACE) nursing program is unique, intensive, and prepares students to begin a rewarding and exciting career with tremendous opportunities. In 2020, Drexel graduates achieved a National Licensure Exam (NCLEX) pass rate of 96.38 percent.

ACE, our 11-month, full-time day program, is designed for those who already have a bachelor's degree and are interested in changing careers and earning a new degree in a condensed time frame. Unlike other programs, we offer immersion learning opportunities and access to expansive clinical affiliations and environments that provide students with the experience they need to excel as medical professionals.


