

## Communication in Autism Parent Coaching Program,

an invitation to participate in research study



The goal of this study is to test a new program called <u>Communication in Autism Parent Coaching Program.</u> The program aims to teach parents of children with Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD) how to build their children's language and communication skills.

## The Facts:

 Approximately 25% of children with ASD do not use language to communicate

- Children with ASD who struggle to communicate are more at risk to show challenging behaviors
- The Communication in Autism Parent Coaching Program developed at the AJ Drexel Autism Institute uses evidencebased strategies to teach communication and language to children with ASD

If you have a child with ASD who has minimal or no verbal communication between 24 and 72 months, you might be eligible to participate in the study

## Benefits to you:

- o Includes a no-cost evaluation of your child's communication & other functional skills
- o Opportunity to receive the Communication in Autism Parent Coaching Program at no cost
  - o Sessions may be in-person, by telehealth, or a combination
- o Participants will be compensated for their time
