

SUMMARY ANNUAL REPORT

For Drexel University College of Medicine Welfare Program (was Philadelphia Health Education Corp. Group Welfare Plan)

This is a summary of the annual report of the Drexel University College of Medicine Welfare Program (was Philadelphia Health Education Corp. Group Welfare Plan), EIN 23-2979433, Plan No. 501, for period January 01, 2009 through December 31, 2009. The annual report has been filed with the Employee Benefits Security Administration, U.S. Department of Labor, as required under the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

Drexel University College of Medicine has committed itself to pay certain self-funded prescription drug claims incurred under the terms of the plan, which were administered on behalf of the plan by Medco Health Solutions, Inc.

Insurance Information

The plan has contracts with Keystone Health Plan East, Combined Insurance Company of America - EyeMed Vision Care, Independence Blue Cross, Amerihealth Insurance Company, Hyatt Legal Plans, Inc., Life Insurance Company of North America and Metropolitan Life Insurance Company to pay health, dental, vision, life insurance, long-term disability, business travel accident, legal services, and accidental death & dismemberment claims incurred under the terms of the plan. The total premiums paid for the plan year ending December 31, 2009 were \$9,547,181.
