## Admissions Checklist

The Master of Science in Medical and Healthcare Simulation Program (MSMS) welcomes international applicants to apply to our program. ***Please note, all items must be submitted before the application will be reviewed by the admissions committee.*** International applicants who wish to be considered for the MSMS program must submit the following:

- Online Application:**

- Application Fee:**
  - Submit the \$65 application fee online: <https://www2.drexelmed.edu/pshspayments/>
- Transcripts:**
  - Applicants must have earned a bachelor's degree from an accredited U.S. institution or an international equivalent.
  - Provide original transcripts in the language of the country of origin and an English translation of the original transcript.
  - Transcripts must be evaluated and transcribed by a credentialing service such as World Education Services (WES), Educational Credential Evaluators, Inc. or International Consultants of Delaware.

- Standardized tests:**
  - Have taken the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) exam and demonstrate proficiency in English with a total score of at least 90.
  - Standardized test scores are not required, however if they have been taken all scores must be submitted. If you have taken the GRE, MCAT, or other standardized tests, please send an official copy of all testing scores to Drexel University.
