



CHEM 050 SUMMER COURSE

FACTSHEET FOR INCOMING FRESHMEN

● What is CHEM 050?

CHEM 050 is a 6-week, self-paced, online course beginning on **Monday, July 21, 2014**. This zero-credit course, offered at no charge, is designed to reacquaint incoming students with the fundamental Chemistry concepts taught prior to college. Successful completion of CHEM 050 will place you into CHEM 101. **The deadline to complete CHEM 050 is Friday, August 29, 2014.**

Please note: CHEM 050 is not an introductory Chemistry course.

● How do I enroll in CHEM 050?

To be considered for CHEM 050, you must take the Chemistry placement exam. If you are identified as a student who would benefit from CHEM 050, you will receive an official Drexel email with instructions on how to enroll in the course. Invitations will be distributed throughout the month of July.

● How do I access my coursework?

Once enrolled, you will be able to access your CHEM 050 coursework online by logging into Blackboard Learn (learn.drexel.edu). If you have any questions regarding CHEM 050, please contact Dr. Daniel King of the Chemistry Department at daniel.king@drexel.edu.

● What happens if I do not complete CHEM 050?

If you do not successfully complete CHEM 050, you will be required to pass CHEM 111 prior to enrollment into CHEM 101, the first Chemistry course required for your degree. Additionally, if you enroll in CHEM 050, you should intend to complete it, or you will risk receiving "No Credit" on your transcript.
