

MATH 050 SUMMER COURSE

FACTSHEET FOR INCOMING FRESHMEN

What is MATH 050?

MATH 050 is a 6-week, self-paced, online course beginning on **Monday, July 21, 2014**. This zero-credit course is designed to reacquaint incoming students with the fundamental Math concepts taught prior to college. Successful completion of MATH 050 will place you into MATH 121.

The deadline to complete MATH 050 is Friday, August 29, 2014.

How do I enroll in MATH 050?

To be considered for MATH 050, you must take the Calculus placement exam. If you are identified as a student who would benefit from MATH 050, you will receive an official Drexel email with instructions on how to enroll in the course. Invitations will be distributed throughout the month of July.

How do I access my coursework?

Once enrolled, you will be able to access your MATH 050 coursework online by logging into Blackboard Learn (learn.drexel.edu). If you have any questions regarding MATH 050, please contact the Math Department at Math050@drexel.edu.

What happens if I do not complete MATH 050?

If you do not successfully complete MATH 050, you will be placed into MATH 110 (or MATH 101 for Biology majors) in the Fall quarter. MATH 110 is a prep course that must be completed prior to enrollment in MATH 121. Note that if you enroll in MATH 050, you should intend to complete it, or you will risk receiving "No Credit" on your transcript.
