Department Highlights:

The calendar year 2009 was a strong year for the Department of Psychology at Drexel. Faculty and students collaborated on a great deal of research; a total of 110 conference presentations and 61 publications (including four books) resulted from these efforts. Extramural funding totaling over \$10 million (including the full amount of ongoing awards) supported this work in 2009. The department's graduate programs are thriving; the doctoral clinical program is one of the most competitive programs in the country, with nearly 500 applications for 10 slots, while the new program in Applied Cognitive and Brain Science was added to the graduate JD-PhD and MS programs. Teaching of undergraduates included both on-campus and online courses, with excellent student ratings for each. In addition, undergraduate majors served as research assistants in a number of faculty labs, working with graduate students to gain experience in applied research to supplement their classroom learning. Psi Chi (the national psychology honors society) and the Psychology Club continue to be vibrant organizations on campus.
