



## INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY

Bachelor of Science in Information Technology (BSIT) students learn how to understand and apply core information technologies; approach the application of information technology from a user-centered perspective aimed at meeting the needs of users and organizations in a societal and global context; apply sound methods and approaches to identify and analyze IT problems and design, implement, and evaluate effective and usable IT solutions; display personal and interpersonal IT career skills, including the ability to work on a team, to communicate with technical and nontechnical people, and to pursue lifelong learning. In addition to the core coursework in information systems and information technology, the major includes 12.0 credits towards a minor in business. Only 12.0 additional credits would be required to complete a minor in business.
