Tuition and Housing Deposits

A tuition deposit is required for all new students as a means of confirming their intention to attend Drexel. The deposit is applied to the first invoice for tuition and fees. Should a student fail to register and/or enroll for the term accepted, it is considered a service fee covering the administrative cost of enrollment — it is **non-refundable**.

In addition, students who enter as freshmen are required to live on campus or with a parent or legal guardian for their first two years. On-campus students must also submit a **non-refundable** housing deposit.

A check or money order should be made payable to Drexel University for these deposits. Be sure to write your Drexel University student identification number — issued in your acceptance letter — on your check or money order. Aside from tuition and/or housing, no other fees or program deposits (e.g., special services, or summer program deposit) should be included in this particular check or money order. You may also deposit online with a credit card at http://discover.drexel.edu. If you deposit online you do not need to submit this form.

Tuition and Housing Deposit Due Dates

Students should submit their tuition and housing deposits by May 1.
