

# Health and Immunizations

## IMMUNIZATION POLICY

To reduce your risk of infection from vaccine-preventable contagious diseases and the risk of a health epidemic on Drexel's campuses, the University requires all full-time students to provide proof of certain immunizations.

### Immunization Record

Drexel University requires all entering domestic full-time undergraduate and graduate students to complete an Immunization Record before initiating the registration process. All full- and part-time international students (including all visa holders and permanent residents) are required to complete an Immunization Record.

*Please note:* A \$35 immunization processing fee is required of all students regardless of where they received their vaccines. This fee will be posted on the student's bill.

For all students attending the University City Campus, Center City Campus, Queen Lane Campus and Drexel University Sacramento, the Immunization Record is available to download from the Health Insurance and Immunization website at [drexel.edu/studentaffairs/hii](http://drexel.edu/studentaffairs/hii).

*International students:* September 1, 2015

#### College of Nursing and Health Professions

### Students enrolled in programs which involve a clinical component

You are required to submit a copy of all immunization records and lab reports to the University. A compliance coordinator will notify you with specific instructions for submitting the completed immunization forms and titers as you get closer to the clinical component of the program.

## HEALTH INSURANCE POLICY

Drexel requires all full-time undergraduate, graduate and international students to have health insurance coverage. All full-time students must demonstrate proof of coverage under a health insurance plan. If you are covered under an existing plan, you must demonstrate proof through our online system. You will receive notification about how to waive/enroll during the summer.

Students will receive reminder emails regarding insurance coverage in their Drexel email account, as well as letters to their home address.

*Students who do not provide the University with proof of insurance by waiving or enrolling in the University-sponsored plan by September 30, 2015, will be automatically enrolled in the Drexel Student Health Insurance Plan for one academic year and be billed to their student account at the appropriate rate.*

*All undergraduate international students and graduate international students with a J-1 visa are required to purchase the Drexel Student Health Insurance Plan. The only accepted plan in lieu of the Drexel Student Health Insurance Plan will be Embassy-sponsored coverage.*
