UPDATES FOR A NEW YEAR

We at Drexel University are focused on providing all Dragons with the support, resources, and opportunities that will allow them to reach their fullest potential as students and scholars. In our ongoing effort to assist students as they prepare to begin their college search, we have implemented the following policy changes to further assist individuals as they consider their academic options.

TEST-OPTIONAL AND TEST-FLEXIBLE POLICIES

Drexel has instituted a Test-Optional Policy for first-year applicants applying for fall 2022 and fall 2023. Applicants interested in the Winter Entry program starting in January 2022 are also eligible. Under this policy, you are able to choose whether you wish to submit standardized test scores to be considered as part of your application. If you do decide to submit scores, you can then follow our Test-Flexible Policy to determine which test scores you would like to submit.

WAIVING OF APPLICATION FEES

In-State First-Year Applicants: In order to better support our local community and as part of our commitment to helping students throughout our Commonwealth excel, we have waived the application fees for all Pennsylvania first-year applicants entering in fall 2022.

Transfer Students: Additionally, to facilitate a more streamlined transition for students in search of a university experience that is more conducive to their individual needs, all application fees for transfer students entering in 2021–2022 have also been waived.

WINTER ENTRY PROGRAM

Designed to accommodate first-year students who require more time to prepare before beginning their college career, the Winter Entry Program provides the option to start your first year at Drexel in the winter quarter, as opposed to the fall, starting in January 2022. As a Winter Entry student, you will receive the same level of academic rigor and preparation your first year as your peers starting in the fall, will be eligible for the same resources and campus activities, and will be at the same point in your plan of study as your fall entry peers as you begin your second year. The deadline for all Winter Entry applications is October 1, 2021.
