Drexel's renowned cooperative education program — also known as co-op — will provide you with the opportunity to apply your skills in the real world. This signature program is offered by the Steinbright Career Development Center, our world-class cooperative education and career development resource.

Drexel Co-op allows you to take full-time positions with Fortune 500 companies, nonprofits, startups, and more. Going on co-op gives you the chance to gain real-world professional experience as you explore different careers and learn what you want to do and what you don't want to do before you graduate. This allows you to network and learn firsthand from industry leaders while simultaneously building an impressive résumé and working side-by-side with the visionaries in your field.

Each co-op takes place over a six-month period, and you'll have the opportunity to go on as many as three, depending on your program of study. This means that you can gain as much as one-and-a-half years of work experience before graduation! And no matter which option you choose, your overall tuition cost will remain the same. When you return to class, your experiences will not only enhance your own classroom learning, you will also be able to share new insights and perspectives with your classmates and professors.

The Steinbright Career Development Center is an invaluable resource throughout your time at Drexel. Steinbright, one of the nation's most advanced career development centers, provides students with a variety of services, including career counseling, workshops, job fairs, and résumé reviews. Steinbright is the pathway to your career.

As soon as you arrive at Drexel, you'll be paired with a co-op advisor who specializes in your field of interest and will serve as a mentor before, during, and after each co-op. You'll also take COOP 101, a 10-week course designed to prepare you for co-op experiences and develop career planning and job search skills that will help position you for success. During co-ops, your co-op advisor will work directly with you and your employer to ensure you are on course with your goals.

When you are ready to launch your job search, Steinbright can assist you by providing guidance, mock-interview feedback, and more. You'll also be connected with our extensive network of employers through Handshake, the online job search tool, and career fairs throughout the year.

PUSH THE BOUNDARIES OF WHAT IS KNOWN

Drexel is a world-renowned R1-designated research institution recognized for our innovative breakthroughs. While you attend Drexel, you will have the opportunity to lead your own initiatives independently and assist Drexel professors and researchers.

Student research begins as early as the first day of class. Our state-of-the-art labs and facilities are conducive to the new discoveries you're most excited about. Students can take advantage of the unique Expressive and Creative Interaction Technologies (ExCITe) Center, an incubator for multidisciplinary research. One of the many initiatives in the ExCITe Center is the App Lab, a workspace for all Drexel community members who are interested in learning about mobile app development.

During the summer of your first year, you can also take part in the Students Tackling Advanced Research (STAR) Scholars Program. In this 10-week program available only to our incoming first-year students, you will conduct a faculty-mentored research or creative project. At the end of the program, you'll present your work and become a published research scholar.

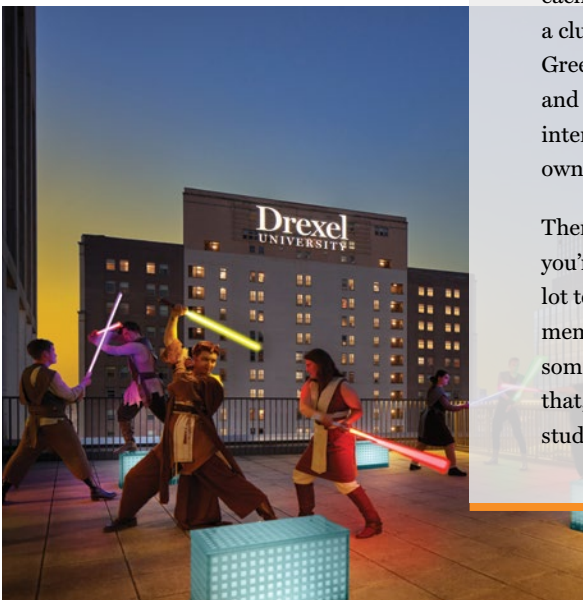




FIND YOUR NEWEST PASSION

Recreation Center

Our Recreation Center, one of the top-ranked in the city, is an 18,000-square-foot facility that is the center for all recreational services at Drexel and includes a multipurpose gymnasium, an elevated jogging track, squash courts, a climbing wall, exercise studios, and other amenities. The

Daskalakis Athletic Center (DAC) is the home of Drexel Athletics and has a swimming pool, golf center, and gymnasium.

Students can also use our outdoor beach volleyball courts; the Vidas Athletic Complex, which includes soccer and lacrosse fields, a field hockey venue, a natural grass multipurpose field, nine tennis courts, and a softball field; and more.

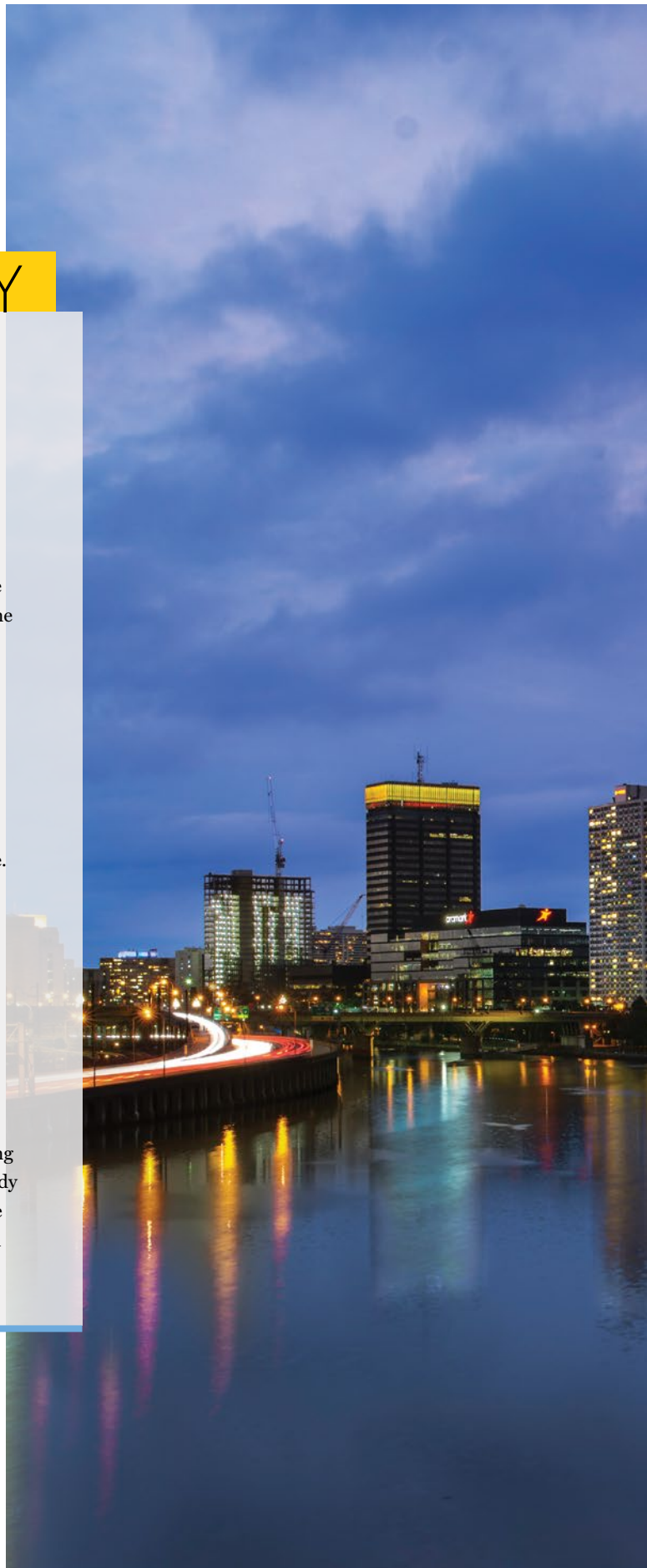
Culture

Center City

Located around Philadelphia's City Hall, Center City is bustling with five-star restaurants, shopping, and high-rises. The area is also home to the Avenue of the Arts, Philly's homegrown response to Broadway.

Chinatown

Just north of Center City, Philly's Chinatown features Asian cuisine for every palate, specialty shops, and iconic landmarks, and the Convention Center right around the corner.
