



# Drexel University Housing Overview

The residential community at Drexel University is composed of several living options for first-year, transfer, upper-class, and graduate students. Drexel is home to approximately 3,400 students residing in residential halls and Greek Life houses.

## 2-Year Residency Program

Drexel University provides a living environment that complements the student’s educational experience and contributes to the student’s growth as a member of the University community and beyond.

To facilitate that experience, full-time undergraduate students who live outside of an approximate 10-mile radius from campus are required to live in a Drexel Residence Hall for their first year. First-year students are not eligible to live in a Drexel fraternity or sorority house or University-Affiliated Housing.

Second-year students are eligible to live in either a residence hall, University-Affiliated Housing, or a fraternity or sorority house.

Students who choose to live in University-Affiliated Housing must contract with the property manager or owner directly and will be responsible for all applicable expenses, including, but not limited to, housing deposits, damage fees, and cancellation fees. All expenses are paid directly to the property manager or owner by the student. Drexel University will not be a party to the individual lease agreement between the student and the property manager/owner and will in no way be required to perform any obligations under such agreement on the part of the student or the property manager/owner, or enforce any individual agreement on behalf of the student or the property manager/owner.

## 10-Mile Radius Listing

The 10-mile radius is defined by the student’s permanent mailing address using their zip code. Drexel University recognizes the following zip codes listed as being within the 10-mile radius.
