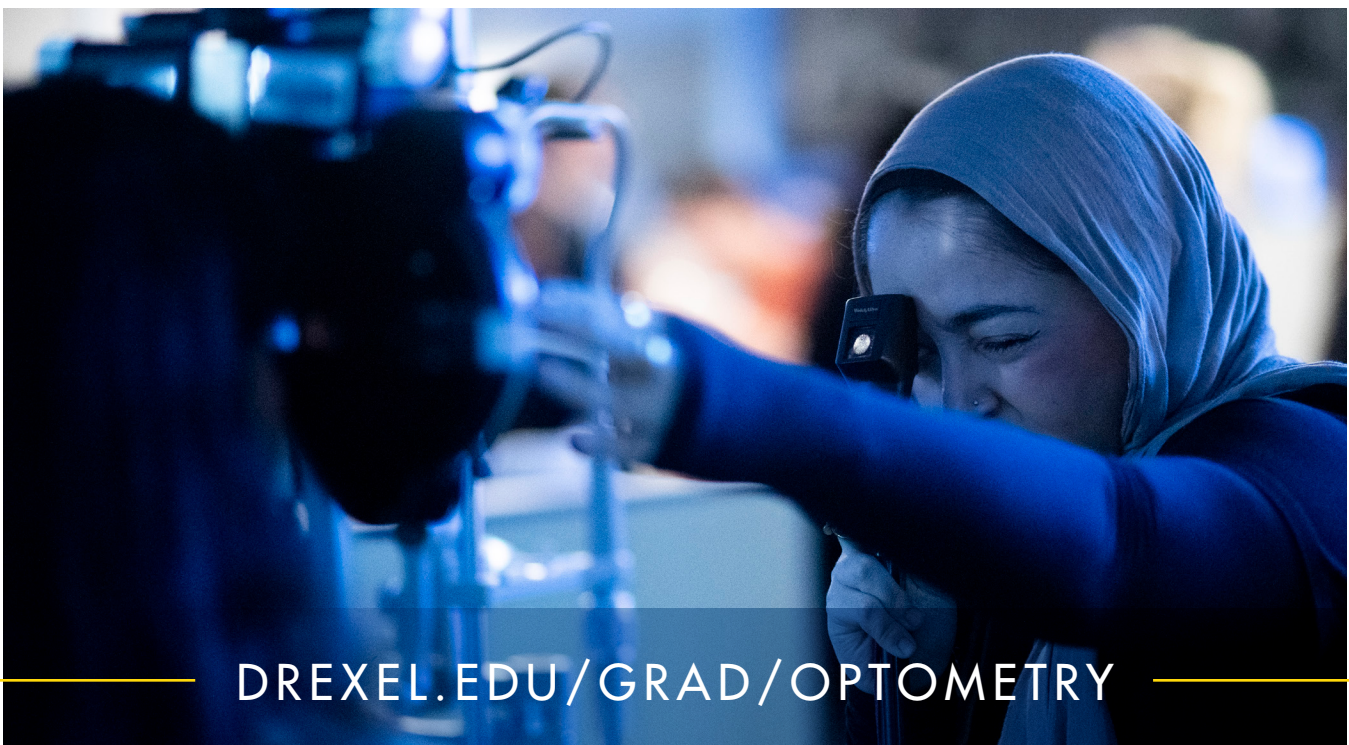

This includes programs in the Blindness and Low Vision Studies (BLVS) department that offers four master's degrees and certificates in Low Vision Rehabilitation (LVR), Orientation and Mobility (O&M), Teachers of Students with Vision Impairments (TVI) and Vision Rehabilitation Therapy (VRT).
