

In 2024-2025, Drexel graduates achieved a National Licensure Exam (NCLEX) pass rate of 96.63%, well above the national average of first-time test takers.

ACE, our 11-month, full-time day program, is designed for those who already have a bachelor's degree, are interested in changing careers, and are interested in earning a new degree in a condensed time frame. Unlike other programs, we offer immersion learning opportunities and access to expansive clinical affiliations, civic engagement opportunities, and environments that provide students with the experience they need to excel as medical professionals serving diverse populations.
