CIES offers services and programming designed to provide academic, personal, and professional support and a space where students are seen and their experiences validated. We also provide broader support to the Drexel community by offering workshops on leadership development, resiliency, and grit, as well as networking opportunities connecting students and scholars from different backgrounds and one-on-one coaching with trained professional staff.

THE CIES STUDENT EXPERIENCE

The moment a Drexel student enters our space, it is the mission of the CIES professional staff to create a sense of belonging and assist our students to get the resources that they need in order to thrive and persist to graduation. As a community hub for Drexel's first-generation students and students of color, CIES offers peer mentoring, academic coaching, textbook loaner library, community service opportunities, lunch and learns, off-campus excursions, and even work-study positions. We even have a weekly newsletter so that students can be informed and stay in the know about everything that's available to them.

Plus, CIES is pleased to offer Saturday Summit, a quarterly event series designed to empower students to reach their academic and personal goals. No matter their year at Drexel, students who attend the Summits leave empowered after hearing from engaging speakers on a range of topics, including wellness, academic preparedness, professional development, leadership, and DEIB (diversity, equity, inclusion, and belonging).
