

UNIVERSITY HOUSING REDEFINED





It is the mission of Drexel University to provide a safe, clean and comfortable living environment that is an essential part of a student's social and educational experience and contributes to the student's growth as a member of the University community and beyond.

To facilitate that experience, full-time undergraduate students who live approximately outside of a 10-mile radius are required to live in a Drexel Residence Hall or University-Affiliated Housing for their first and second years. First Year (freshmen) students must live in a Drexel Residence Hall; Second Year (sophomore) students may live in a Drexel Residence Hall or University-Affiliated Housing. Sophomores also have the option of living in a Drexel fraternity or sorority house with invitation from the organization.

The 10-mile radius is defined by the student's permanent mailing address using their zip code. Drexel University recognizes the zip codes listed as the 10-mile radius.

Fast Facts

- The residential community at Drexel University is comprised of several living options for first year, transfer, upper-class and graduate students. Drexel is home to approximately 4,500 students.
- First Year (Freshman) students are <u>not</u> eligible to live in Drexel fraternity or sorority house or University-Affiliated Housing.
- Second Year (sophomore) students who choose to live in University-Affiliated Housing must contract with the property manager or owner directly and will be responsible for all applicable expenses, including but not limited to: housing deposits, damage fees, and cancellation fees. All expenses are paid directly to the property manager or owner by the student. Drexel University will <u>not</u> be a party to the individual lease agreement between the student and the property manager/ owner and will in no way be required to perform any obligations under such agreement on the part of the student or the property manager/owner, or enforce any individual agreement on behalf of the student or the property manager/ owner.
- Study Abroad & Co-op:
 - Drexel University Housing recognizes that Drexel students are dynamically engaged in academic-affiliated experiences. Students residing in a Drexel Residence Hall have the flexibility to cancel without penalty for academic-affiliated programs such as study abroad and co-op experiences that are obtained outside of a 10mile radius of the University City Campus.
 - Students who choose to live in University-Affiliated Housing must contract with the property manager or owner directly and will be responsible for all applicable expenses, including but not limited to: housing deposits, damage fees, and cancellation fees.
