PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The First-Year Exploratory Studies (FYES) program at Drexel University is designed for students who wish to explore various academic disciplines before committing to a major. This program offers a structured yet flexible plan of study, allowing students to discover their interests and strengths while also examining all that Drexel's Colleges and Schools have to offer. By the end of the first year, students are prepared to transition into their chosen major with confidence and clarity, as well as remain on track with credits.

INNOVATIVE CURRICULUM

The FYES program curriculum is tailored to provide a comprehensive educational experience that aligns with your individual personal and professional goals. Schedules are customized to foster exploration and intellectual growth, ensuring that students gain a broad understanding of multiple fields. With manageable credit loads, students have the opportunity to reflect on their own academic journeys and make informed decisions about their futures.

TRACKS

The FYES program gives students the unique opportunity to explore disciplines from across Drexel's unique colleges and schools before declaring a major. Each major has specific entry requirements that FYES advisors will explain to support a smooth transition to the intended degree program at the end of the year. Students can also create their own interdisciplinary academic plan through the Custom-Designed major offered through Pennoni Honors College. Advisors help students make informed decisions that will enable them to succeed.

DREXEL CO-OP

TRANSFER STUDENTS WELCOME

Students who have completed less than 26 semester credits and are looking to transfer to Drexel but still aren't sure what they want to major in, the FYES is an ideal option. Students can seamlessly transfer into the FYES program for the following terms:

- WINTER (JANUARY)
- SPRING (LATE MARCH/EARLY APRIL)

A Fall (September) start date in the second year may also be possible depending on the student's unique circumstances. Drexel's academic advisors will work closely with transfer students to ensure that credits are maximized toward completing a degree on time.
