#### INTERMEDIATE LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY

# Accelerated Degree Programs

## **ACCELERATED DUAL DEGREE PROGRAMS**

Accelerated degree programs enable academically qualified students to earn **both** a bachelor's and an advanced degree simultaneously, typically saving up to one year of time in comparison to traditional programs. In these programs, students accelerate the completion of their undergraduate courses and complete their graduate studies during their fifth year.

## **ELIGIBILITY AND REQUIREMENTS**

Depending on the academic program, eligible undergraduate students can be admitted to an accelerated degree program in one of two ways: as an incoming freshman, or as a current student — after completing a minimum of 90 credits but no more than 120 credits.

## **EARLY ASSURANCE PROGRAMS**

The College of Arts and Sciences, in cooperation with Drexel's College of Medicine and the Kline School of Law, offers a number of early assurance programs. These highly specialized and competitive program offerings must be selected when students apply to Drexel University as incoming first year students. These early assurance programs guarantee students admission to either the Drexel University College of Medicine's MD program or the Kline School of Law's JD program provided they meet certain criteria while completing their undergraduate degrees. In addition, students in these programs receive extra support and relevant advising\* in addition to special event invitations and student community-building. Please reach out to your admissions counselor for information about applying to an early assurance program. Interested students must apply for these programs along with their first-year admissions application.

\*Note – Students who are not part of an early assurance program cohort are still eligible for dedicated pre-health and prelaw advising and are encouraged to participate in these advising communities. Contact your academic advisor once you matriculate for more information.
