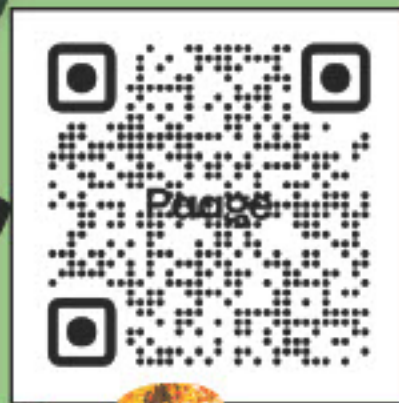

## WHY SHOULD I RIDE?

### SEPTA's Decreased Service

With news of fewer SEPTA services, avoid busy roads in the city by using a bike to get around!

### Clear Lanes

Starting December 2024, cars can no longer stand, stop, or park in bike lanes

### Piece of Mind

Philadelphia continues to work to improve bike lanes by improving markings and delineators!

## HOW DO I RIDE?



- Have a front white light and a back red reflector on your bike
- Use hand signals when turning
- Ride on the street with traffic, not on the sidewalk
- Follow traffic laws
- Use the full lane when on narrow streets
- Approach intersections cautiously
- Do not wear headphones

## LOCK YOUR BIKE!

U-locks should be placed around the bike frame through the triangle and wheel rim, then around the bike rack.

# Philadelphia Road and Transportation Authority

Over the years, bicycle fatalities have surged  in the past decade, with 1,105 cyclist deaths in 2022—the highest since records began in 1975 (Ken McLeod, 2024)

## WHY KNOW THESE RULES AGAIN?

### Where Can You Ride?

**Bikes:** Bike lanes, roads, and shared-use paths.  
No sidewalks (unless under 12).  
**E-Scooters:** Streets & bike lanes only.  
No sidewalks!  
**Crosswalks:** Yield to pedestrians.

**Speed & Safety Rules**  
**E-Scooters:**  
15 mph max (10 mph in slow zones).  
Follow all traffic laws: Stop at lights, signal turns, ride with traffic.  
No riding under the influence!

### Parking Rules

Park responsibly in racks, designated scooter docks, or curb edges.  
No parking in crosswalks, bus stops, or blocking sidewalks!  
Violations may lead to fines or removal.

**Philly's Shared Mobility Services**  
Indego Bike Share – 24/7 access, discounts for low-income residents.  
Dockless Scooters & E-Bikes – City pilot programs expanding!  
Car-Free & Slow Streets Zones – Prioritizing bikes & pedestrians.

## BECAUSE PHILADELPHIA IS TAKING BOLD STEPS TOWARD SAFER STREETS, FASTER COMMUTES, AND CLEANER AIR.



The Congestion Pricing Zone (CPZ) and Odd-Even Rule are launching to cut peak-hour congestion by 40%, reduce emissions, and improve pedestrian and cyclist safety.



Every dollar generated—\$500M annually—will be fully reinvested into building a Philadelphia that moves smarter



- Expanded SEPTA services for reliable, faster public transit.
- Protected bike lanes & pedestrian-priority zones for safer streets.
- Smart crosswalks & AI traffic signals to prevent accidents.
- Micromobility hubs & shared transit expansion for first/last-mile connectivity.

With these policies, we're seeing fewer crashes, lower commute times, and a thriving, walkable city.

# Bridging Mobility Gaps: A Community-Centered Approach to Equitable Transportation in Philadelphia

Ensuring safe, affordable, and accessible transportation for all

## 1 Community-Led Transportation Design

Workshops in underserved neighborhoods to co-design transit solutions. Partnerships with local organizations to align policies with community needs.

## 2 Micromobility Hubs & Safer Streets

Develop micro mobility hubs with bike storage, transit connections, and digital/traditional kiosks to reduce access barriers. Prioritize Complete Streets for safer, multimodal access.



## 3 Seamless Public Transit & Micromobility Integration

One membership card for SEPTA & Indego (Apple Pay, Google Pay, etc.). Fare discounts for low-income residents (modeled after Portland's system).

## 4 Better Accessibility & Safety

Legalize & regulate e-scooters for safer, affordable travel. Enforce fines to prevent bike lane blockages & improve safety.

Reduces barriers to jobs, healthcare, and social services.  
Creates safer streets and better transit access for all.

## What are my options?



Own a bike? You're ready to go!

Don't own a bike? No problem! Pedal and e-bikes are available at Indego Stations throughout Philly!



## How do I rent a bike?

It's simple! Tap your **Septa Key Card** to use an **Indego bike**!



## Look for the Bike Sticker on Rail Cars!



## Safety first!



Philadelphia **encourages** the use of **helmets** and **protected bike lanes** for all cyclists, with helmets being required only for those under 13 years old

## Know your rights and responsibilities!



- A bicycle is a legal vehicle; you get the same rights as a car!
- Motor vehicles must give 4 feet of space to pass you!
- Bicycles are only allowed on sidewalks if you are walking it!
- Bikes are allowed on any city road!
