WHAT IS ROTAVIRUS?

Rotavirus is a highly contagious virus that can cause severe diarrhea, vomiting, fever, and dangerous dehydration.



Rotavirus Vaccine is a 2 or 3 doses, depending on the brand of vaccine used.

Almost all babies who get rotavirus vaccine will be protected from severe rotavirus diarrhea.



Both rotavirus vaccines are administered orally. This means the rotavirus vaccine is administered by putting drops in the child's mouth.

- ✓ Dose 1 Day 0
- ✓ Dose 2 2 Months Later
- ✓ Dose 3 6 Months After First Dose

FAQ

- Do I need insurance to get the HPV vaccine?
- No. Many clinics offer sliding scale payment options. Programs like the Merck Patient Assistance Program may provide the vaccine at no cost.
- Is my vaccination information private?
- Yes. Your vaccination status is confidential.
- What does the HPV vaccine protect against?
- GARDASIL 9 protects against 9 types of HPV that cause anal, throat, and penile cancers, as well as genital warts.
- Why is this important for LGBTQ+ men?
- HPV-related anal and throat cancers are more common among men who have sex with men. Vaccination significantly reduces your risk.

WHAT IS HPV?

HPV is a common sexually transmitted infection (STI) that is highly infectious and often asymptomatic

HPV ACCOUNTS FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF MORE THAN

HPV vaccines have been shown to reduce the risk of HPV-related cancers by 56% in men

HPV can spread through skin-to-skin contact, not just intercourse
