

Doctoral Student Funding Waiver

In order to sustain and grow the School's doctoral education programs, School of Public Health faculty are strongly encouraged to include doctoral student support on *research grant budgets* whenever possible. The integration of doctoral students in the research enterprise represents a critical component of their training and external support for doctoral students will provide necessary funding for expanding the school's doctoral education offerings.
