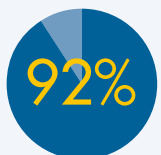

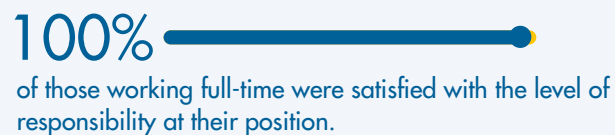
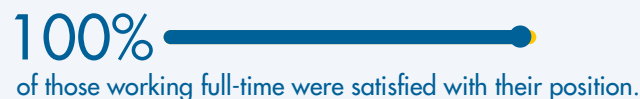
From the One-Year-Out Alumni Survey, graduating class of 2020:



92% of Education graduates are working or enrolled in graduate or professional education.

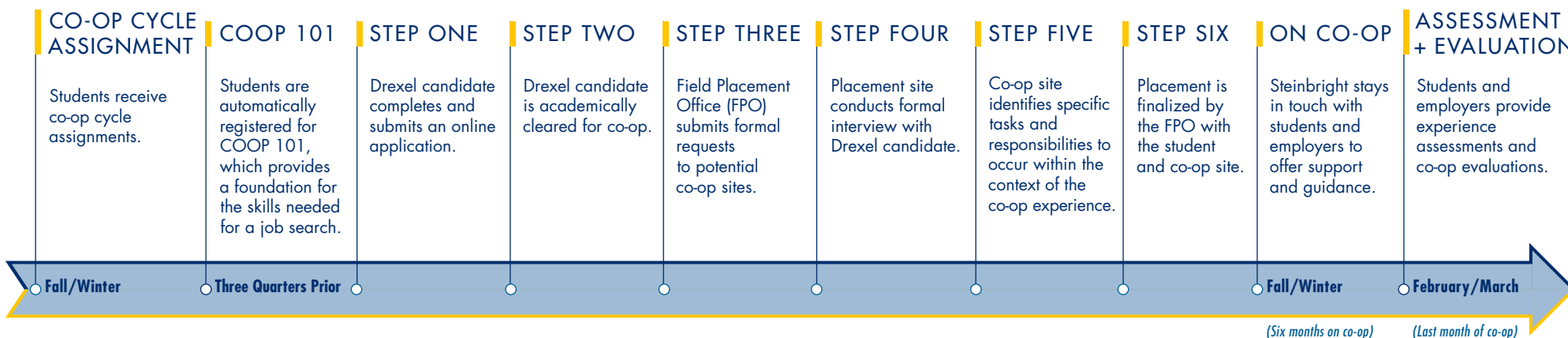


25% of Education co-op participants working full-time had received a job offer from a former co-op employer.
