

## Drexel University Transit Services SEPTA Strike Contingency Plan

---

**\*NOTE:** This plan will take effect **ONLY** in the event of a SEPTA strike, beginning the morning of the first business day immediately following the beginning of the strike.

### **Bus Service**

Drexel and University of Pennsylvania buses will pick up passengers in the morning from the PATCO station located at 15<sup>th</sup> and Locust Streets and on Market Street at Chatham Road next to R K Food Mart.

In the afternoon and evening, the buses will pick up passengers at the bus zone located at 33<sup>rd</sup> and Market streets next to Nesbitt Hall and at the southeast corner of 33<sup>rd</sup> & Walnut streets. These bus services are free and available to all students, faculty and professional staff of both institutions. Riders must present a valid Drexel University or University of Pennsylvania ID card. ### **Schedule**

The following schedules will be followed as closely as possible; however, please note that there will be increased traffic due to the strike that may cause delays. **“D”** indicates Drexel University vehicles  
**“P”** indicates University of Pennsylvania vehicles.

**Walnut Street and Chestnut Street Shuttle**

Drexel will be providing bus service starting at 33<sup>rd</sup> and Market streets (southwest corner) next to W.W. Haggerty Library and operating west to 63th and Market streets. The return trip will be east to Chestnut Street at 33<sup>rd</sup> Street. The service will pick up and drop off in designated bus zones along the route. Upon entering the shuttle, Drexel University students, faculty and professional staff must present a valid Drexel University ID. The times for this route are as follows; service pickups be approximately every 30 minutes:

5 a.m. to 9:30 a.m.  
2:30 p.m. to 12 a.m.

**Drexel Campus Bus Service**

The Dragon Route, Blue & Gold and Queen Lane Campus Bus Service will continue running on the same schedule as posted. Upon boarding a shuttle bus, Drexel University students, faculty and professional staff must present a valid Drexel University ID.

### **LUCY (Loop through University City)**

LUCY will continue normal service. These bus routes loop through University City, serving 30<sup>th</sup> Street Station, Drexel University, University of Pennsylvania, University City Science Center, University of Pennsylvania Medical Center, Presbyterian Medical Center, The Children's Hospital of Philadelphia, Children's Seashore House and VA Medical Center.

LUCY runs Monday through Friday, except major holidays\* from 6:10 a.m. to 7 p.m. (\*New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving and Christmas Day).
