

HEALTH INSURANCE DEDUCTIBLE SUBSIDY PROGRAM FOR GRADUATE STUDENTS

The Graduate Student Association established the Drexel Aetna Student Health Insurance Deductible Subsidy program in 2021, in collaboration with the Graduate College and Student Life, to assist full-time graduate students in quarter programs enrolled in Drexel's Aetna student health insurance plan to reimburse their deductible payment. The current in-network deductible for the Drexel Aetna student health insurance plan is \$100.

Drexel graduate students enrolled full-time (9 credits) in quarter programs, including master's and doctoral students, who are currently enrolled in Drexel's Aetna student health insurance plan are eligible to apply for the subsidy.

Semester students in the Division of Biomedical Science Programs in the Graduate School of Biomedical Sciences can also apply for the subsidy funded by the BSGSA via a separate application.

Eligible students must submit a completed application with all required and relevant materials via the Drexel Funding Portal (InfoReady).
