- Allows users to create a sound organizational structure for their reference material.

Install on a Drexel-owned Mac

Install and activate on a personal-owned PC

1. Download the EndNote installer from OnTheHub. For more info, see [Download software from OnTheHub](#).
 2. Once the download has completed, double-click (or double-tap) the downloaded installer.
 3. If you see the User Account Control prompt that says, **Do you want to allow this app to make changes to your device?**, select **Yes**. You might need to enter an administrator username and password.
 4. On the first installation screen, select **Next** to begin the installation process.
 5. Enter your license key from OnTheHub, and then select **Next**.
 6. Complete your user information, and then select **Next**.
 7. On the next installation screen, select **Next**.
 8. Review the end user license agreement. Select **I accept the license agreement to agree to the license terms**, and then select **Next**.
 9. Choose how you want to install EndNote, and then select **Next**.
- Note:** If you want to install specific application features, select **Custom**, and then select **Next**.
10. Review the install location or change your install location, and then select **Next**.
 11. Select **Next** to begin the installation.
 12. Select **Finish** when the installation is finished.

Creating/Opening an EndNote Library

- To create a new EndNote library:
 - Go to **File** → **New**
 - Select a save location
 - Enter a file name for your library
 - Library name: **EndNote –EndNote Library STEM** in our example
 - Keep library open to import citations from databases
- To open EndNote library:
 - Go to **File** → **Open Library**
