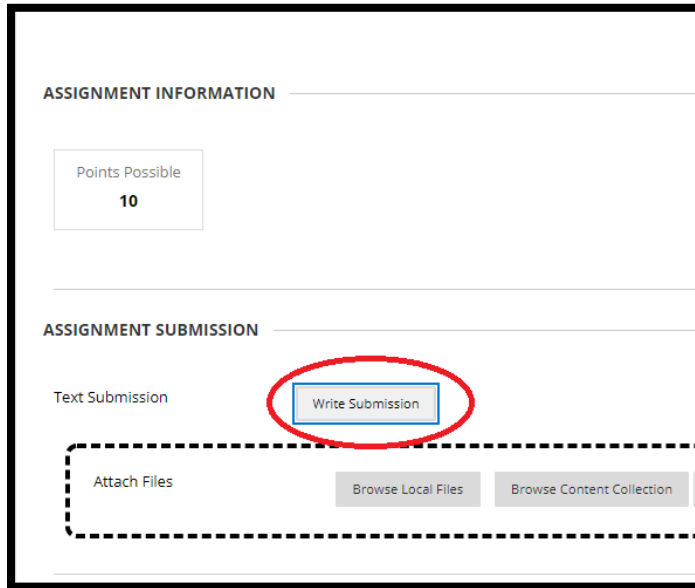
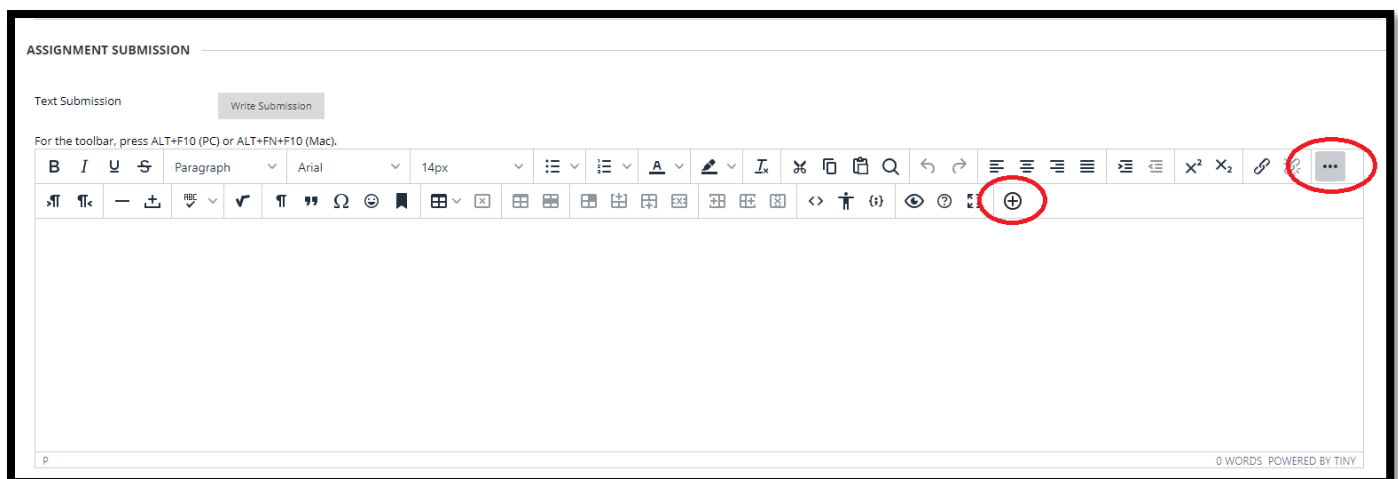


Submit a Video from Drexel Streams to an Assignment or Discussion Forum in Blackboard Learn (Student)

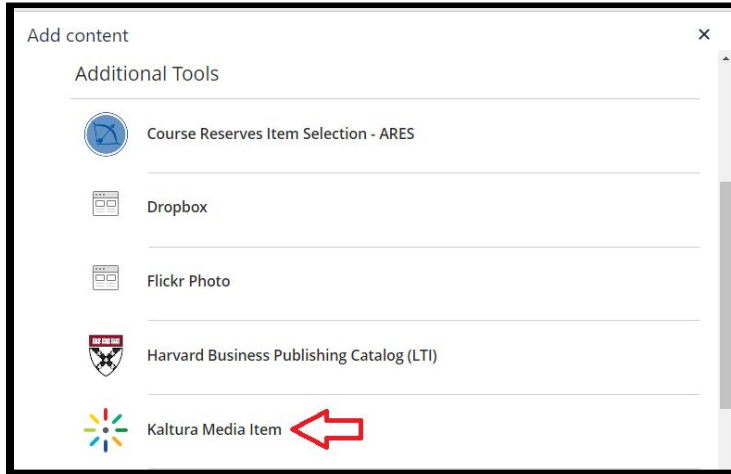
1. In Blackboard navigate to the assignment.
2. Click on the **Write Submission** button.



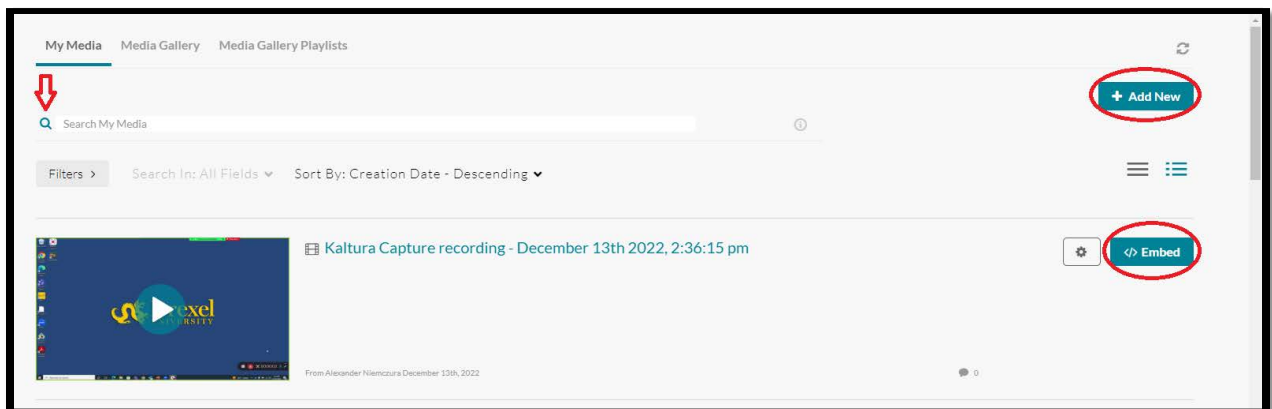
3. Ensure that all three lines of the Text Editor are visible. If they are not, click on the **More** button in the upper-right corner.
4. Click on the **Add Content** button.



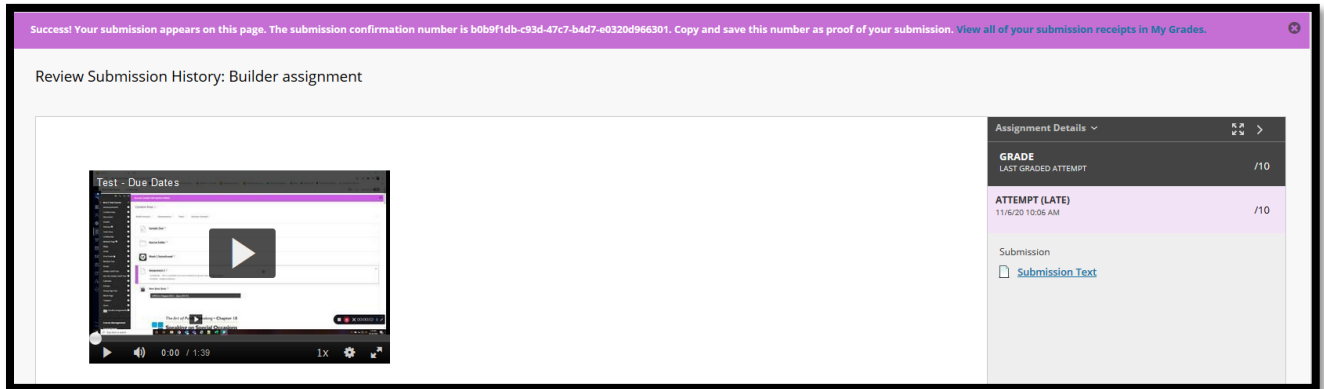
5. In the **Add Content** window, click **Kaltura Media Item**.



6. A window will appear with a list of your Media from Drexel Streams.
7. If submitting an existing video, use the Search field at the top along with the filter options to find the video in your Drexel Streams My Media. Click on the **</> Embed** button at the right to select the video you would like to insert.
8. If submitting a new video, click **+ Add New** to upload your video to Drexel Streams.



9. You should now see the thumbnail of the video in the Assignment viewer. Add any desired text into the submission field and press **Submit** to finish.
10. You will see your submission and a confirmation message at the top after you hit **Submit**.



If adding a video to a discussion post, the process is quite similar.

1. Within the desired forum, click the **Create Thread** forum to create a new thread. Alternatively, if replying to a post in an existing thread, click the **Reply** button for the post to which you wish to reply.
2. Use the text editor to insert your Drexel Streams video using the same steps outlined above.
3. Click **Submit** when finished to add your video to the discussion.
