1. Résumé
2. A personal statement (two pages maximum) – please upload as a “cover letter”
  - (a) highlighting your experience and/or interest in municipal government
  - (b) explaining why an internship the Solicitor’s Office “fits” who you are and what you think you might want to do after graduation
  - (c) identifying two to three (maximum) practice group units within the Solicitor’s Office where you would prefer to work (ranking your preference and explaining your choices)
