

PRE-ORIENTATION CHECKLIST

Please complete the below items before arriving on August 21st

- Activate your accounts
- Make sure your laptop meets minimum hardware and software requirements
 - Note the exam software does not run on iOS or Chromebooks
- Apply for Financial Aid
- Enroll in or waive Health Insurance (deadline: ASAP)
- Complete Immunization Forms (deadline: ASAP)
- <u>Submit your photo for your DragonCard</u> (deadline: Aug. 11). If you miss the deadline, you may not receive a DragonCard during Orientation, but can get one at the DragonCard Office)
- Review transfer credit letter and <u>Fall course schedule</u>, and discuss course registration with <u>Dean Theresa Gallo</u> (deadline: Aug. 15)
- Use the "Buy Course Materials" link in <u>DrexelOne</u> to purchase textbooks as needed (click "Shop By Schedule").

Note that e-versions of textbooks may not be accessible to you in an exam. If an instructor has not listed an e-book as an option or otherwise noted that e-books are permitted, you should avoid purchasing e-versions of texts.
