### **Biographical Sketch**

Kate Campbell Hurd-Mead, M.D. (1867-1941) is best known for her seminal history work titled; <u>A History of Women in Medicine, From</u> the Earliest Times to the Beginning of the Nineteenth Century, Haddam Press, Haddam CT, 1938. Among the other publications in this field is "A Short History of the Medical Women of Connecticut" (1925) and "Trotula" (1930). A partial "manuscript" (notes and biographical data) projected for a "History of Medical Women in England" (volume three) appear in this collection. The Schlesinger Library holds another unpublished manuscript, "Women in Medicine in the Eastern Hemisphere" (volume two). Hurd-Mead graduated from the Woman's Medical College of Pennsylvania in 1888.

### Provenance of Collection

In 1949, at the death of Prof. William E. Mead, "medical books and pamphlets" (including personal papers) from Dr. Kate Hurd-Mead's book collection were transferred to the Woman's Medical College of Pennsylvania's library via Prof. Mead's will, apparently fulfilling his wife's wishes. The Archives accessioned the Hurd-Mead collection in 1978.

### Processing note

This collection was processed in May 1978 when a number of decision were made resulting in the dispersion of some materials such as "reprints" (medical reprints; newsclippings; books) to the "Reprint File collection" (RF-II). Photographs have been removed to the Photograph collection. Hurd-Mead's rare book collection (medical history, biography, and general interest) comprised of 187 [?] items had been placed on shelves with reference collection, in oversize map case drawers, and separated (in storage closet) for donation to other institutions. No notes describing the reasoning behind these decisions were found.

In an attempt to bring the various items back into one collection, re-processing (new arrangement, re-boxing and re-foldering) was initiated in August of 1994. All previous processing notes, preliminary registers, etc. have been retained in the donor file for Acc. 43.

Scope and Content Types of materials

Personal Papers: correspondence (alphabetical) Contains mostly congratulations regarding Hurd-Mead's book, ca. 1938. Of special interest is historian Mary R. BEARD's file. manuscript (broken pagination) Referred to as a manuscript but actually composed of Hurd-Mead's notes, and numerous letters, autobiographical sketches and c.v.'s English women physicians collected by of Florence Cowlin, M.D. (presumably on behalf of Dr. Hurd-Mead).

Haddam Garden Club: correspondence - 1930s publications

Books and Reprints: Medical (catalogued and uncatalogued on reference shelves) Span dates 1520-1938.

> Non-Medical (in Box 4 and "oversize" map case - Acc. 43) Contains general history, travel, art, atlases, etc.
