Brief statement of contents:

1 scrapbook (1940-1951) - The greater part of this scrapbook of Dr. Catharine Macfarlane's contains newspaper clippings and printed material on such subjects as the history and discrimination of women in medicine and on the research, prevention, and treatment of cancer. A large portion of the scripbook deals with a visit to the U.S. made by Eve Curie in honor of the 50th anniversary of the discovery of radium and to help in a cancer fund drive which covered the years 1945-1948. Other printed materials, such as dinner invitations and campaign brochures, refer to this crusade. Dr. Macfarlane's speech at her 71st birthday celebration and the presentation speeches of the seventeen women named as Distinguished Daughters of Pennsylvania (of which she was one in 1949) are also found in this book.
