Description: The donor purchased these prints at a flea market in Germany or England.

Additional Comments: These prints were found in a file cabinet containing items from the office of a previous director of the Archives. An acknowledgment letter and Deed of Gift was never sent, but the note from the donor indicates the intent to donate. No accession number was assigned, and there was no accession record or finding aid created for these items. And so, this accession record has been created in October of 1997, even though the gift was donated in 1994.
