Description: The donor believes the photo was taken at the Woman's Medical College of Pennsylvania and that the woman in the back row center is her aunt, Emma Patchett. "She was in the class of 1902, but withdrew from Medical College on the death of her father in 1901 in order to be with her mother."

Additional Comments: These photographs were found in a file cabinet containing items from the office of a previous director of the Archives. An acknowledgment letter and Deed of Gift had been sent, the Deed of Gift signed and returned, and an accession number assigned, but there was no accession record or finding aid created for these items. And so, this accession record has been created in October of 1997, even though the gift was donated in 1995.
