**Notes:** These materials were placed in the Queen Lane Library for sharing with University faculty, staff and students. The Committee for the University was formed shortly after the Allegheny Health Education and Research Foundation (AHERF) declared bankruptcy in July 1998. It was made up largely of faculty with the purpose of assisting the "educational and health services mission of the Allegheny University of the Health Sciences...by proposing an economic plan for the University which will bring about the reorganization of the University in its bankruptcy proceedings as a self-controlled enterprise; effecting the discharge of the reorganized University from its bankruptcy proceedings; and by raising contributions and by other means the financing that may be required to fund the reorganization plan and the start-up of stand alone operations."
