Additional Comments: According to correspondence the manuscript must have been donated around the end of 1990 or early in 1991, though there was no Deed of Gift. There is now a Deed of Gift (dated 2002) for the manuscript. (See accession file.)

Since its arrival at the Archives it has been stored with the rest of this artificially-created collection of materials on Edith Flower Wheeler. They now continue to reside together with the above accession number, but only the manuscript has a Deed.

The source of the class minutes book and "The Weekly Scrapper" was Edith Flower Wheeler herself, who donated these items to the College library in 1947 and 1948 respectively. It seems that she also sent the clippings at various intervals, some as late as 1954. The menu from the 1897 class commencement luncheon seems to have been removed from another artificially created collection, the "Autograph Collection", which has since been largely dismantled, though some do still exist together. There is no evidence of provenance on this piece.
