Drexel University College of Medicine excels and innovates in education, research and delivery of compassionate care in our culture of diversity, spirited inquiry, collaboration and opportunity.


Vision

Our Planning Process

In September 2018, the College of Medicine began an inclusive strategic planning process that purposefully engaged a diverse group of stakeholders across multiple departments who, through their work together, identified the strategies, timelines, necessary resources and indicators for success for our agreed-upon objectives.

The strategic planning process was overseen by a steering committee and included five working groups. Faculty were encouraged to serve on a group unrelated to their everyday scope of work and were comprised of a variety of faculty across all departments. Our broader community also had the opportunity to share their input and recommendations through an online survey.

The working groups addressed the key areas of undergraduate medical education, graduate medical education, the Graduate School of Biomedical Sciences and Professional Studies, research, and the clinical enterprise.

Strengthening Foundations

Objective

Recognizing that our pillars of education, research and clinical care are strengthened by our commitment to our students, faculty and staff, Drexel University College of Medicine will invest in efforts to make the College an outstanding environment in which to learn, work and thrive, to secure the foundation for the next phase of the College's advancement.

Strategies

- Drexel University College of Medicine will create a more inclusive faculty workforce, creating clear expectations of the responsibilities of our leadership and enabling departmental and institute efforts to enhance diversity and inclusion.
- DUCOM will develop a comprehensive plan for faculty advancement, with special attention to the advancement of junior faculty, women and minorities underrepresented in medicine.
- DUCOM will support an initiative to better align performance to compensation for all faculty.
- DUCOM will develop a plan for faculty wellness, including an understanding of care models that can optimize patient care and mitigate clinician burnout.
- DUCOM will reduce MD program student indebtedness to the national median by 2024.
- Working with University leadership,

DUCOM will establish a task force to develop a master facility plan to create a physical infrastructure to support growth in educational and research programs with the goal of consolidating medical school functions into one geographic location.

 DUCOM will strengthen and grow basic and translational biomedical research and clinical research within the College of Medicine as a platform for collaborating with the other academic units within Drexel University.

Strategies

- DUCOM will expand its commitment to undergraduate medical education by establishing a four- year regional campus in collaboration with Tower Health.
- DUCOM will increase collaboration with other units within Drexel University and the major clinical affiliates of the College of Medicine around research and scholarship,

including comparative efficacy and outcomes, clinical service delivery, health disparities, clinical trials, biomedical science and biomedical engineering.
