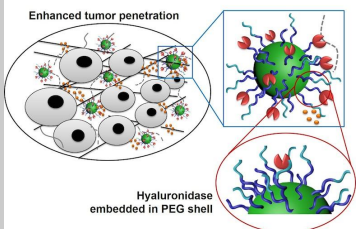
Young Girl Gives Back
