Ellen Yin – 2023 Woman One Honoree



Ellen Yin, MBA, has over 25 years of experience as an owner/operator of multiple restaurants in Philadelphia including Fork, High Street Philly, a.kitchen & a.bar, and High Street Hoagies, through her company, High Street Hospitality Group (HSHG).

This spring Ms. Yin was named the 2023 James Beard Foundation's Outstanding Restaurateur. HSHG restaurants have received high ratings from the press including Fork (which received three bells from critic Craig LeBan and was a three-time semifinalist for James Beard Foundation's Outstanding Restaurant Award); High Street on Market (which also received three bells from LeBan and was named the 2014 *Bon Appetit* Best New Restaurant); a.kitchen (which earned three bells from LeBan, is a two-time recipient of *Wine Enthusiast's* Top Wine Restaurant designation, and was a semifinalist for the James Beard

Foundation's Outstanding Wine Program Award) and High Street on Hudson (which received two stars from the *New York Times* and was named a Michelin Bib Gourmande).

Ms. Yin holds an MBA from the Wharton School of Business and is involved on the boards of many community organizations including the Philadelphia Award, Delaware River Waterfront Corporation, Arden Theatre Company. She is a founding member of Sisterly Love Collective, a nonprofit to elevate the voices of women in the food and beverage space.

She is being honored with a 2023 Woman One Award for her success as a restaurateur, her support of women in the restaurant industry and her community leadership.
