What is Drexel HOPE?

Drexel HOPE™ provides quality health services for opioid use disorder, HIV and Hepatitis C. We offer virtual and in-person care at low or no cost, which makes medical services more convenient for underserved patients.

Services include:

- Opioid use disorder treatment, including medications,
- Support during opioid use disorder recovery,
- Training and tools for overdose reversal and prevention,
- HIV and Hepatitis C testing and treatment,
- Medication and safer sex resources for HIV prevention,
- Connection to local resources for wellbeing and further medical care,
- Free community education to reduce stigma about all the above.

We will start offering virtual appointments in the early summer. Our mobile medical van will be out in the community once COVID-19-related restrictions are lifted.
