Background

Child health research lags significantly behind innovation in adult populations

Many therapies are unstudied, or protocols are dated

- Need for increased development of Child Health Research identified 13 years ago
- The Pediatric Research Office (PRO) initiated support of clinical research studies in 2008
- CHRI Planning and development continued across UNMC and CHMC through 2017
- CHRI Approved by the Univ of Neb Board of Regents and the Children's Hospital & Med Ctr Board in 2017

Objectives

- Establish a highly accountable institute that fosters the ability for faculty to conduct highimpact research and secure extramural funding
- Create an environment of inquiry and discovery to recruit productive senior faculty and to foster development of child health physician scientists via a pipeline of trainees
- Secure resources within CHRI to facilitate member research (statistician, scientific writer, internal grant review)
- Develop philanthropic strategies and relationships

Methods/Approach

- Revise and finalize an agreement between UNMC and CHMC to fund and govern CHRI
- Develop Membership Categories and Criteria
- Refine the Internal Grants Process to best serve the mission of transitioning to external grants
- Establish functional research Areas of Emphasis for CHRI to promote collaboration and increase research SUCCESS
- Establish a dashboard and scorecard to evaluate progress
- Establish CHRI UNCM/CHMC Intellectual Property Guidelines


