ABOUT DragonsTEACH MIDDLE YEARS

DragonsTeach Middle Years (DTMY) is a Drexel University program that allows students to keep their chosen major and become a certified middle years (grades 4-8) teacher. DTMY students experience teaching through inquiry-based instruction by taking education courses with their electives and completing student teaching experiences at local schools. This program addresses the local need for more qualified middle school teachers and provides students the opportunity to explore teaching.

Earn up to \$30,000 towards tuition!

Applications are being accepted for the prestigious Robert Noyce Teacher Scholarship program at Drexel University. Scholarship award winners will receive \$15,000 annually for up to two years for a total of \$30,000.

▶ WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

All Drexel STEM majors who enroll in the DragonsTeach Middle Years program are eligible for the scholarship. Scholarship recipients must commit to teaching for two years for each year they receive the scholarship.

▶ HOW TO GET STARTED

To enroll in DragonsTeach Middle Years, register for ESTM 201 (offered Fall, Winter & Spring). Note: this course satisfies the service requirement for CIVIC 101 if taken in the same term.
