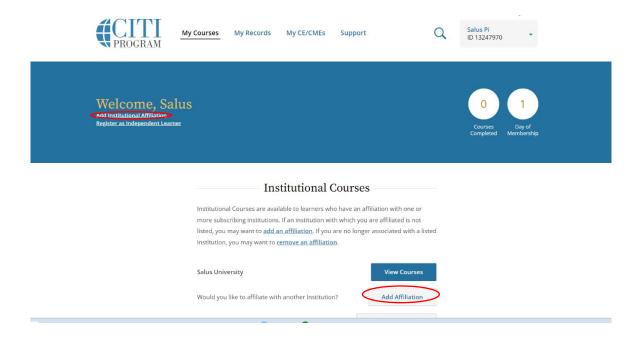
Affiliating your CITI Account with Drexel University

Using your existing CITI account set up with Salus University, follow these steps to affiliate with Drexel University.

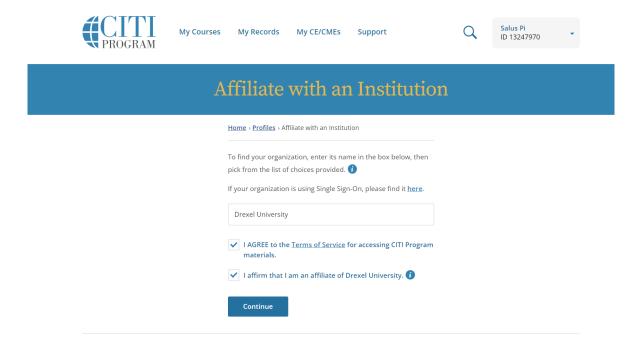

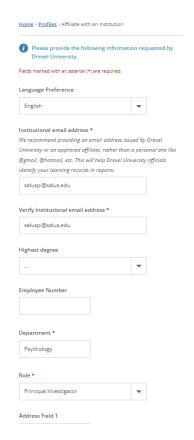
3. On your home page, click on "Add Institutional Affiliation" in the top blue Welcome banner or below in the "Institutional Courses" section.



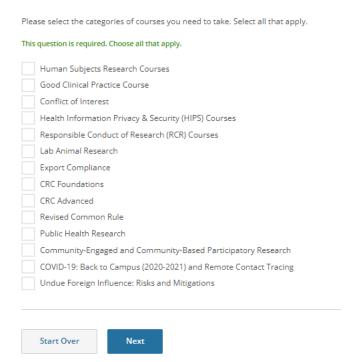
4. Search "Drexel University" and select from the drop down. Then check boxes below to agree to the Terms of Service and affirm affiliation with Drexel University.
