Knowledge	<ul> <li>Recognize employment trends and expand industry knowledge</li> <li>Develop job focus by reviewing archive of co-op positions and Dragon Jobs job descriptions</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Research companies of interest on LinkedIn to broaden list of employers</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Meet with alumni, faculty and professionals for informational interviews to cultivate industry knowledge and a foot in the door</li> </ul>
