Re: Drexel University Fall 2020 Hybrid Course Delivery

To whom it may concern,

The Office of International Students and Scholars Services (ISSS) at Drexel University certifies that our institution will *not* operate in an entirely online mode of instruction in the Fall 2020 term.

Course delivery will be conducted using a hybrid model, and there will be more than adequate course offerings to allow the student to make normal progress in their degree program. The purpose of this support letter is to certify that the holder of this letter and a Drexel University-issued I-20 plans to participate in Drexel's hybrid mode of instruction in the Fall 2020 term.

While the SEVP/ICE provided updated guidance pertaining to the Fall 2020 term on July 6th, which included the addition of remarks to each student's I-20 document outlining the institution's planned mode(s) of instruction, the guidance was rescinded on July 14th in a federal court hearing. While we wait for updated guidance from the SEVP/ICE, please accept this letter outlining Drexel's Fall 2020 course delivery plan in lieu of I-20 remarks in the interim.
