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Introduction

The purpose of the Neighborhood Survey is to collect data about the community prior to implementation of West Philly Promise Neighborhood supported programs. This baseline data was collected from a sample of households in the West Philadelphia Promise Neighborhood footprint with children age 0-18. In each household, the survey participant was a primary caregiver of children living in the household. The survey participants have been enrolled in a study that will include three waves throughout the 5-year Promise Neighborhood grant (January 1, 2017-December 31, 2021). This will create a database of information about the participants' survey responses over time. This data can be used to assess changes in resources and outcomes over the course of Promise Neighborhood service, program, and systems implementation. Eligible households were asked questions about up to three children in that household. Some questions in the survey were only asked of children in a certain age category (0-5 year olds (but not in yet enrolled in school, K-8th grade, and high school aged children). The survey has four main topic areas: education, health, family and community. Surveys were programmed into Qualtrics, a program used to collect data electronically, and the interview was administered via tablet by 18 surveyors, including 15 community members and 3 graduate students. The first wave of the survey was fielded from January to July 2018.

This codebook represents the data in wave 1 of West Philly Promise Neighborhood's (WPPN) biannual neighborhood survey as of September 11, 2019. There is a total of 297 households represented in this data for wave 1. Up to three children were selected per household, this resulted in a total of 507 children being represented in the data.

Notes on Use

Each variable, or data item in the codebook will be presented in a table containing information about the variable name, question (if applicable), and responses.

If the question responses are multiple choice, data will include the count and percent for each response option and the number of people who were asked the question but did not provide an answer. Questions that allowed more than one response will only show the response options. Counts and percentages for each option or a combination of options can be provided upon request. All questions where respondents were instructed to provide a numeric value the tables will include the total number of responses, average, and the lowest and highest value of all responses. Examples include age, height, and weight.

The total number of people who were asked each question can be determined by adding the total counts of responses plus the total number of those who did not answer. Please note that the total percent of each response option is weighted, meaning it is calculated in a way that makes it more representative of the entire WPPN population.

If there is no question associated with a variable name, it is because that variable was created by the WPPN data team post-survey. These are included in the created variables section.
